Role

Procedure of evaluation

- We had established a system of points to be accorded for each criteria, in order to make this as objective as possible
- Project evaluation is a double blind process (evaluators will not be known to the project authors and vice versa)
- The list of evaluators will be published on the EATA web page

Requirements and skills:

- member of EATA community
- research experience
 - Experienced researcher: previous participation as a researcher in research projects and having published research articles and/or PhD in Humanistic or Social Sciences having published research articles.
 - CTA trainer is a must as a lowest level of professional competencies, but PhD is a plus not a mandatory competency for evaluators.
- Previous experience in project evaluation is a plus
